Thank you so much for your incredible contributions to ChildFund Australia over the past 4 years.

Your generous contributions of \$6,335.70 in cash donations have helped to continue and expand ChildFund's operations in our partner countries, improving the lives of children who need it the most.

In addition to our initial Covid-19 response, which provided handwashing stations, protection kits and food, we've been able to provide an additional 26 families living in the Horn of Africa with food provisions for 2 months, including 24kg of maize which is a staple used in many dishes. Food packs also include 10kg of nutritious beans, peas or lentils and 2L of oil for cooking.

ChildFund's work focuses on promoting the participation and protection of children in community life. Our vision is a world without poverty where all children and young people, regardless of their birthplace, can say: "I am safe. I am educated. I contribute. I have a future.".



At a time when the rising cost of living has seen the need for food relief significantly increase, our mission to Nourish our Country is more important than ever.

On any given day, over half a million households in Australia are struggling to put food on the table, with those with children are being hardest hit. The rising cost of living is the most common reason (64%) that people are struggling to put food on the table, with increased cost of food, energy and housing contributing the most*Foodbank Hunger Report

Additionally, OzHarvest reports that throughout their network of recipient charities, 30% of the people seeking support are doing so for the first time.

Rainforest Rescue are delighted to partner with Goodtel. Please accept this letter as confirmation that we gratefully accept the donations made to date totaling \$2,096.47.

Although the Daintree is part of the larger World Heritage area, there are many sections of its coastal lowland rainforest that remain **unprotected**. Rainforest Rescue fundraises to buyback and protect vulnerable intact rainforest that is not already part of the protected Daintree National Park.

So far, 42 properties and 1,776,851 square metres of Daintree lowland rainforest has been saved and protected forever by Rainforest Rescue. Goodtel's donations will enable Rainforest Rescue to keep undertaking this important work and is equivalent to the contribution towards protection of 419 square metres of unprotected Daintree rainforest habitat.

We look forward to working together to Protect Rainforests Forever.
