Dear Damien and the Goodtel team,

Thank you so much for your incredible contributions to ChildFund Australia over the past 4 years. Your generous support in total \$7,473.76 has helped to continue and expand ChildFund's operations in our partner countries, improving the lives of children who need it most.

In addition to the initial COVID-19 response, which provided handwashing stations, protection kits and food, you have also provided an additional 26 families living in the Horn of Africa with food provisions for 2 months, including 24kg of maize which is a staple used in many dishes. Food packs also include 10kg of nutritious beans, peas and lentils and 2L of oil for cooking.

Your recent donation of \$555.03 has now provided mosquito nets to an additional 55 children to prevent the suffering caused by mosquito transmitted diseases such as malaria, dengue and yellow fever. Overall, your support has now provided more than 100 children with life-saving protection from mosquito transmitted diseases. Every two minutes somewhere in the world, a child dies from malaria. That risk is now reduced for children and their families because of your generosity.

Our vision at ChildFund Australia is a world without poverty where all children and young people, regardless of their birthplace, can say: *"I am safe. I am educated. I contribute. I have a future."*, which could not be possible without the commitment of supporters like you.

Thank you so much for your generous contributions to OzHarvest to date. The total of \$8403.82 donated by Goodtel so far has allowed us to provide **16,808 meals for those in need**. In addition it has enabled:

- 8,404kg of food saved from landfill
- 55,465kgs of greenhouse emissions prevented through avoiding food waste
- 2,899,380 litres of water saved

At a time when the rising cost of living has seen the need for food relief significantly increase, our mission to Nourish our Country is more important than ever. On any given day, over half a million households in Australia are struggling to put food on the table, with those with children are being hardest hit. The rising cost of living is the most common reason (64%) that people are struggling to put food on the table, with increased cost of food, energy and housing contributing the most\* Foodbank Hunger Report

OzHarvest is also committed to halving food waste by 2030, inspiring and influencing others to do the same, and transforming lives through education.

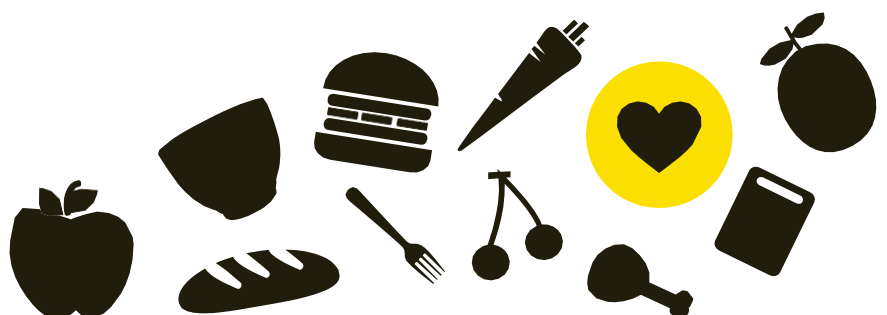
